



Henstone Old Dog Corn Liquor

A mash bill of 68% corn, 16% wheat and 16% barley is distilled in Hilda; their pot/column hybrid Still. This is then matured in new American oak casks for 25-months to produce a liquor that is a great alternative for the bourbon drinker. Lots of orange on the nose, with flavours of salted caramel, orange and vanilla.

Vol: 10cl | ABV: 41.5% | Type: Corn Liquor | Cask: New American Oak

Neat - 30ml in a glass... look at it, smell it, drink it! Over ice works too.

OD Coke - 30ml over ice, coke of choice... Done!

Old Dog Fashioned - Muddle ½ spoon of sugar, bitters and ice, add 40ml OD an orange twist and amarena cherry...

100ml gives you the chance to try all three!
